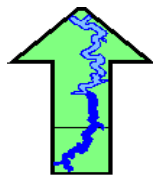

You are cordially invited to attend the Fifth Annual Mon River Summit on Monday, April 19, 2010, in Morgantown, WV at the Waterfront Place Hotel.

Recognizing the unique opportunities provided by the Monongahela River to its river basin communities, industry and citizens residing within the basin, The Upper Monongahela River Association has scheduled the Fifth Annual Monongahela River Summit to provide a forum for a discussion of river issues in Pennsylvania and West Virginia.

This year's theme is ENERGY ISSUES, DRINKING WATER, and the DUNKARD CREEK FISH KILL: Current Issues and Emerging Opportunities for the Mon River. The keynote address, "One river and two states: a personal and professional perspective for balancing competing demands from industries, regulators, and the public" will be presented by Colonel Mike Crall, Pittsburgh District Commander, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

The summit will also feature experts on commerce, industry, infrastructure, and recreation from Pennsylvania and West Virginia. A special focus will be on recent water quality issues affecting the river and the impacts on industry, drinking water supply, and recreation in both states.

Proceedings following the summit will be prepared outlining the problems and solutions presented at the summit and will be available on the summit website.
